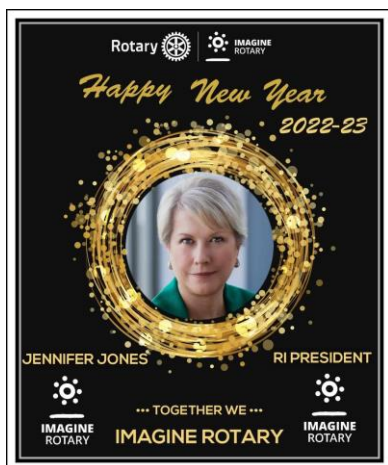
Meeting opened with the National Anthem. Martin Harrison introduced the following guests:
